

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-135-642

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A FINAL MILLAGE RATE AT A PUBLIC HEARING, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2007, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2008; PROVIDING FOR DIRECTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2007, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2007-120-627 determining a proposed Millage Rate for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2007 ("Fiscal Year 2007/2008"), and scheduling the public hearings required by Section 200.065 of the Florida Statutes to be held on September 12, 2006 and September 25, 2006, at 6:00 p.m. and

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2007, the proposed millage rate and budget were approved by the City Council, and

WHEREAS, the public and all interested parties have had the opportunity to address their comments to the City Council and the City Council has considered the comments of the public regarding the millage rate,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.


Section 2. ADOPTION OF FINAL MILLAGE RATE: The City Council hereby adopts and establishes the final millage rate for the City of Miami Gardens for FY 2007/2008 at 5.1488, which is which is \$5.1488 per \$1,000.00 of assessed property

within the City of Miami Gardens, Florida. Said millage rate represents a 21.27% increase over the roll-back rate OF 4.2458.

Section 4: DIRECTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK: The City Clerk is directed to advertise said public hearing as required by law and to certified copies of this resolution to the Property Appraiser, Tax Collector, and the Miami-Dade County Board of County Commissioners.

Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE: This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A FINAL MILLAGE RATE AT A PUBLIC HEARING, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2007, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2008; PROVIDING FOR DIRECTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Florida Statutes provide a fixed method for the adoption of municipal budgets. This process requires that a "Proposed Millage Resolution" be adopted in early September and a "Final Millage Resolution" be adopted two weeks later. This resolution is the second or final millage resolution for FY 08.

This resolution establishes our FY 07-08 millage at 5.1488, or the same amount as in FY 06-07.

RECOMMENDATION: That City Council approve the resolution setting the final millage rate at 5.1488 mills per \$1,000 of taxable value and further.
