A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE AND ATTEST, RESPECTIVELY, MEMORANDUMS OF UNDERSTANDING WITH ALL PROVIDERS WHO WILL BE PROVIDING SERVICES PURSUANT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS AND THE CHILDREN'S TRUST, IN SUBSTANTIAL FORM AS THAT AGREEMENT ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "A"; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Gardens has been awarded \$750,000.00 from the Miami-Dade County Children's Trust to fund it's Youth Violence Initiative, and

WHEREAS, the City is required to enter into Memorandums of Understanding with all third party agencies that will be providing any services in accordance with the Grant,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.



A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE AND ATTEST, RESPECTIVELY, MEMORANDUMS OF UNDERSTANDING WITH ALL PROVIDERS WHO WILL BE PROVIDING SERVICES PURSUANT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS AND THE CHILDREN'S TRUST, IN SUBSTANTIAL FORM AS THAT AGREEMENT ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "A"; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Staff Summary

In July 2006, a group of concerned citizens, government officials, members of the Children's Trust Board of Directors, and its staff convened to discuss the rash of violent deaths suffered by youth, many resulting from gun violence. Miami-Dade County Commissioner Barbra Jordan, also a member of The Children's Trust Board, challenged Trust staff to establish a tangible process to impact the community in a positive way. Shortly after, The Children's Trust Board identified \$3 million in Trust funds to put towards a competitive process seeking community-based solutions.

The City of Miami Gardens led the effort to build a coalition with several government agencies and community-based organizations throughout the Miami Gardens and Opa-Locka communities, which resulted in a proposal to reduce violent actions against youth by providing services to 4569 youth between the ages of 5-18 and 200+ parents.

At the December 2006 Board meeting of the Children's Trust, the City of Miami Gardens' proposal received unanimous approval to be fully funded in the amount of \$750,000, along with an option to renew for two additional years. The Children's Trust has deemed our first year performance a success and has extended an offer to renew the contract for another year, February 1, 2008 – January 31, 2009, in the amount of \$750,000. On June 11, 2008 the City Council passed a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute the second year contract #825-301.

According to the Children's Trust requirements, the lead agency must establish Memorandums of Understanding with its budgeted coalition members to ensure services are delivered and desired targets are met. Our coalition members include: City of Opa-Locka, City of Opa-Locka Police Department, Community Crusade Against Drugs, Concerned African Women, Informed Families, Teen Upward Bound, Peace Be Still, Project IMPACT, The Portrait of Empowerment, Youth Coop. Form MOU is attached.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Council approve this resolution to allow the City Manager to establish Memorandums of Agreement with coalition members identified in the second year Children's Trust Child Murder and Youth Violence Prevention Grant 825-301.

This Contract, made this ___ day of _____, 2008, by and between the City of Miami Gardens, located at 1515 NW 167 Street, Building 5, Suite 200, Miami Gardens, Florida, 33169 and _____, located at _____ agree to this memorandum of understanding and clauses and conditions that comprise the City of Miami Gardens and The Children's Trust primary contract for the rendering of services to children and families to satisfy The Children's Trust Child Murder and Youth Violence Prevention Initiative Contract Number 825-301.

Whereas: In 2007 the City of Miami Gardens formed a coalition with agencies and organizations within the Miami Gardens and Opa-Locka communities to develop a comprehensive program to address the problems outlined in The Children's Trust's Child Murder and Youth Violence Prevention Initiative.

Whereas: For the second year Miami Gardens has been awarded \$750,000 to serve as the lead agent to implement the proposed scope of services develop by the Coalition.

The Parties agree that the initial effective term of this Contract shall be from **February 1, 2008 to January 31, 2009**.

Subject to available funds, the maximum amount payable for Services rendered under this MOU shall not exceed \$ _____. Approved itemized budget is attached (Attachment B).
