A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE PURCHASE ORDERS TO STANDBY SYSTEMS, INC., FOR THE PURCHASE AND DELIVERY OF GENERATORS WITH TRAILERS AND ATTACHMENTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$74,661.00; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City is in need of an emergency standby generator for certain City facilities in case of a power outage, and

WHEREAS, City staff advertised ITB #07-08-045 on July 23, 2008, and

WHEREAS, eleven (11) bids were received and publicly read, and

WHEREAS, Standby Systems, Inc., was the apparent low bidder, and

WHEREAS, City staff is recommending, that the City Council authorize the City Manager to issue a purchase order to Standby Systems, Inc., for the purchase and delivery of generators with trailers and attachments,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.



A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE PURCHASE ORDERS TO STANDBY SYSTEMS, INC., FOR THE PURCHASE AND DELIVERY OF GENERATORS WITH TRAILERS AND ATTACHMENTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$74,661.00; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Staff Summary

City Council authorized the purchase and installation of an emergency standby generator for City Hall on October 24, 2007, to be purchased with UASI Grant funding. Staff has identified additional facilities that would benefit from having power when an emergency occurs. These facilities are the Parks maintenance compound, Cloverleaf Park, A.J. King Park and Scott Park. Public Works has identified a need for additional generators to power street lights.

The Department of Homeland Security, through the Office of Grants and Training is providing financial assistance to several agencies in the Fort Lauderdale urban area. Financial assistance will be provided to the City of Miami Gardens through the Fiscal Year 2006 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Program for the purchase and delivery of the emergency stand-by generators with a remaining balance of \$108,000.00.

Analysis:

Staff prepared specifications for the purchase and delivery of four 25 KW generators with trailers, manual transfer switches and cords for the parks facilities and three 5 KW generators for the traffic lights.

The solicitation ITB#07-08-045 advertised on July 23, 2008. A broadcast notice was sent to 686 vendors. Fifty-three vendors requested bid packages. The bids were opened on August 14, 2008. Eleven bids were received and publicity read. The tabulation sheet is attached as Exhibit "A".

All of the bid submittals were evaluated for compliance with the specifications. The apparent low bid meeting all of the City's minimum specifications is Standby Systems Inc. located in Melbourne, Florida. As noted in the attached tabulation sheet, bids received from Blanchard Machinery; American Equipment; and Power Depot were lower than recommended vendor, however, the afore-mentioned companies failed to meet the City's minimum requirements as it relates to technical specifications for the products laid out in the bid.

A copy of the bid document and submittals are available at the Assistant to the Mayor and Council's office for review.

Recommendation:

The City Council approve the attached resolution authorizing the City Manager to issue a purchase order for the purchase and delivery of four 25KW generators with trailers, transfer switches and cords and three 5KW generators to Standby Systems Inc. located in Melbourne, Florida in the amount of \$74,661.00.
