A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT, AND ANY AND ALL ATTENDANT DOCUMENTS, IN ORDER TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$46,390.00 FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MIAMI GARDENS POLICE DEPARTMENT "PEDESTRIAN/BICYCLE SAFETY PROGRAM;" PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Gardens, through its Police Department, has applied for, and been awarded, grant funding from the Florida Department of Transportation in the amount of \$46,390.00 to be used in furtherance of the Miami Gardens Police Department "Pedestrian/Bicycle Safety Program," and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Program will be to reduce injuries and increase the safety of pedestrians and bicyclists in the City of Miami Gardens, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate for the City Manager to execute an Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation in order to receive the grant funds,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. AUTHORIZATION: The City Council of the City of Miami Gardens hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with the

Florida Department of Transportation, and any and all attendant documents, for receipt of a grant in the amount of \$46,390.00 for the implementation of the Miami Gardens Police Department Pedestrian/Bicycle Safety Program.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.

Staff Summary

The Miami Gardens Police Department has applied for and been awarded grant funding from the Florida Department of Transportation in the amount of \$46,390. These funds are to be used in furtherance of a program entitled "Miami Gardens Police Department Pedestrian / Bicycle Safety Program". This program will focus on reducing injuries and increasing the safety of pedestrians and bicyclists in the City of Miami Gardens. This will be accomplished by a variety of means including educational forums, helmet giveaways and school zone enforcement initiatives. The goal of this program will be to increase public safety for those who live, work and attend schools in the City of Miami Gardens.

Recommendation:

That the City Council approve the attached resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a contract with the Florida Department of Transportation allowing the Miami Gardens Police Department to utilize the \$46,390.00 for the implementation of the Miami Gardens Police Department Pedestrian/Bicycle Safety Program.
