A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER TO MUSCO SPORTS LIGHTING, LLC, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$79,990.00 BY RELYING UPON THAT CERTAIN CITY OF JACKSONVILLE BID SC-0511-06; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to install lighting along the new tennis courts at Rolling Oaks Park, and

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville has awarded Bid Number SC-0511-06 for sports lighting, to Musco Sports Lighting, LLC, and

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Gardens would like to rely upon that certain City of Jacksonville Bid Number SC-0511-06,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.



Title

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Staff Summary

The attached resolution is requesting the authorization by City Council to issue a purchase order to Musco Sports Lighting, LLC in the amount of \$79,990 for athletic sports lighting along the new tennis courts Rolling Oaks Park. As part of the overall park infrastructure improvements, an upgrade to the existing light poles was determined to be a priority. Since the park will be utilized for day and night time games, proper illumination of the field is warranted.

Staff identified a qualified municipal contract that can be utilized for these services; the attached quote reflect the pricing utilizing the City of Jacksonville bid SC-0511-06. The City of Jacksonville competitively bid for park and playground equipment; Musco Sports Lighting, LLC was awarded sports lighting.

The new field lighting is reflective of the standardized design for all future park designs, exhibiting L.E.E.D. (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) elements, green

principles and focused projection allowing minimal reflection into neighboring residences. Additionally, Musco Sports Lighting has recently been installed with success at existing basketball court and playground at Rolling Oaks Park.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that City Council approve the attached resolution authorizing the issuance of a purchase order for the purchase of athletic sports lighting at Rolling Oaks Park, in accordance with the City of Jacksonville bid in the amount of \$79,990.00 to Musco Sports Lighting, LLC.

Payment Terms

Net 30 days from shipment of product

Late payment will be subject to service charges of 1 ½% per month (18% APR).

Musco will attempt to coordinate shipment so that delivery corresponds with the customer's payment schedule. It will be the responsibility of the wholesaler to ensure that Musco is aware of this delivery timeframe. We will expect payment within the terms described above unless there is a written statement from Musco's corporate headquarters stating the acceptance of different terms.

Delivery to the job site from the time of order, submittal approval, and confirmation of order details including voltage and phase, pole locations is approximately 30-45 days. Due to the built-in custom light control per luminaire, pole locations need to be confirmed prior to production. Changes to pole locations after the product is sent to production could result in additional charges.

- Shipment of entire project together to one location
- 4 Tennis courts (in sets of 2)
- 480 Volt, 3 Phase electrical system requirement
- Structural code and wind speed = 2004 w/2006 High Velocity Hurricane Zone supplement, Florida Building Code, 146 MPH Exposure C.
- Confirmation of pole locations prior to production
