

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-167-1112

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A FINAL MILLAGE RATE AT A PUBLIC HEARING, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2009, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2010; ESTABLISHING THE ROLLBACK RATE; PROVIDING FOR DIRECTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 22, 2009, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2009-154-1099 determining a proposed Millage Rate for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2009 ("Fiscal Year 2009/2010"), and scheduling the public hearings required by Section 200.065 of the Florida Statutes to be held on September 8, 2009, and September 21, 2009, at 6:00 p.m. and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended an annual budget for Fiscal Year 2009-2010 commencing October 1, 2009, and

WHEREAS, the public and all interested parties have had the opportunity to address their comments to the City Council and the City Council has considered the comments of the public regarding the millage rate,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. COMPUTATION OF THE ROLLBACK RATE: The roll-back rate for FY 2009/2010 is \$5.3734.

Section 3. ADOPTION OF FINAL MILLAGE RATE: The City Council hereby adopts and establishes the final millage rate for the City of Miami Gardens

for FY 2009/2010 at 5.3734, which is the same as the rolled-back rate. This represents the levy of \$5.3734 per \$1,000.00 of assessed property within the City of Miami Gardens, Florida.



Millage Resolution

Florida statutes provide the procedure for the adoption of the City's budget and proposed millage. The first advertised millage resolution was heard at the September 8th City Council meeting. This is the second millage resolution to be heard at the September 21st meeting. This resolution reflects the calculated roll-back rate of 5.3734.
