

ORDINANCE No. 2005-29-67

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY M & M DEVELOPMENT, INC. TO APPROVE A ZONING DISTRICT BOUNDARY CHANGE FROM GU, INTERIM TO RU-TH, TOWNHOUSE, FOR PROPERTY GENERALLY LOCATED AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF NORTHWEST 37TH AVENUE AND 189TH STREET, MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT A ATTACHED HERETO; PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN CODE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, M & M Development, Inc. (Applicant) has filed an application with the City of Miami Gardens to approve a zoning district boundary change from GU, Interim to RU-TH, Townhouse, for property generally located at the Northeast corner of Northwest 37th Avenue and 189th Street, more particularly described on Exhibit a attached thereto, and

WHEREAS, City staff has reviewed the Application and is recommending that the City Council approve the Applicant's request, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held on this matter, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the Application and approved the same,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas Clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. APPROVAL: The City Council for the City of Miami Gardens hereby approves the Application submitted by M & M Development, Inc., for a zoning district boundary change from GU, Interim to RU-TH, Townhouse for property generally located at Northwest 37th Avenue and 189th Street, more particularly described on Exhibit A attached hereto. Se

SECTION 3. CONFLICT: All ordinances or Code provisions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.


SECTION 5. INCLUSION IN CODE: It is the intention of the City Council of the City of Miami Gardens that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Miami Gardens and that the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word "Ordinance" may be changed to "Chapter," "Section," "Article" or such other appropriate word or phrase, the use of which shall accomplish the intentions herein expressed; provided, however, that Section 1 hereof or the provisions contemplated thereby shall not be codified.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its final passage.
