

RESOLUTION NO. 2004-28-79

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA; URGING MIAMI DADE COUNTY TO ACQUIRE A PARCEL OF UNDEVELOPED LAND CONSISTING OF APPROXIMATELY 186 ACRES PROPERTY LOCATED ON THE SOUTHEASTERN CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF N.W. 47 AVENUE AND N.W. 215 STREET FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PUBLIC PARK; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Gardens recognizes the need for green areas, open lands and passive and active recreational facilities for the use and enjoyment of all the residents of Miami-Dade County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Gardens acknowledges the limited availability of undeveloped lands that can be acquired for the establishment of public parks for the enjoyment and benefit of all the residents of Miami-Dade County, including the residents of the City of Miami Gardens; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Gardens takes notice that a parcel of undeveloped land consisting of approximately 186 acres located on the southeastern corner of the intersection of N.W. 47 Avenue and N.W. 215 Street (the "Property") is presently available for acquisition; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Gardens finds that, if acquired, the Property could be utilized and developed as a public park for the use and enjoyment of the residents of Miami-Dade County and the residents of the City of Miami Gardens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:



Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.


