

RESOLUTION No. 2004-94-145

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS RECOMMENDING THAT THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS RENAME THE "MIAMI GARDENS/CAROL CITY DISTRICT POLICE DEPARTMENT" TO THE "CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS POLICE DISTRICT"; PROVIDING FOR INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Gardens was incorporated in May of 2003, and

WHEREAS, the City recently entered into various Interlocal Agreements with Miami-Dade County, including an Interlocal Agreement for the provision of local police services, and

WHEREAS, in light of the fact that the City of Miami Gardens is now incorporated, the area that used to be known as Carol City has now become merged into the City of Miami Gardens, and

WHEREAS, the Miami Gardens/Carol City District Police Department is wholly within and only provides services to the City of Miami Gardens, and

WHEREAS, naming the Police Department as the "City of Miami Gardens Police District" would create a sense of added security and civic pride to the residents of the City, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Miami Gardens would like to urge the Miami-Dade County Board of County Commissioners to rename the "Miami Gardens/Carol City District Police Department" to the "City of Miami Gardens Police District",

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby

made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. RECOMMENDATION: The City Council of the City of Miami Gardens hereby recommends that the Miami-Dade County Board of County Commissioners rename the "Miami Gardens/Carol City District Police Department" to the "City of Miami Gardens Police District".

Section 3. INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK: The City Clerk is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this Resolution to each of the members of the Miami-Dade County Board of County Commissioners.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.
