

RESOLUTION No. 2006-40-386

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT, IN SUBSTANTIAL FORM AS THAT AGREEMENT ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "A", WITH CROWDER-GULF FOR THE PROVISION OF EMERGENCY DISASTER DEBRIS REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, there is an immediate need after a hurricane for the City to remove debris, and

WHEREAS, although the City relies upon Miami-Dade County for solid waste and debris removal, in an emergency situation, often times the County is not able to respond as quickly as the City's needs warrant, and

WHEREAS, the City Manager is recommending to the City Council that it contract with a company to provide emergency debris removal and clean-up services in the event of a hurricane, and

WHEREAS, City staff prepared specifications to retain qualified company(s) to provide disaster debris removal and disposal services in the RFP document 05-06-009 ("RFP"), which was advertised on February 23, 2006, and

WHEREAS, seventeen (17) proposals were received in response to the RFP, and

WHEREAS, City staff composed a selection/evaluation committee and selected two (2) of the responding firms for recommendation to the City Council, and

WHEREAS, the City Manager is recommending that the City Council enter into an agreement with Crowder-Gulf to serve as one of the contractors to be utilized by the City

to provide the requested services,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.


Section 2. AUTHORIZATION: The City Manager for the City of Miami Gardens is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute an Agreement in substantial form as that Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" with Crowder-Gulf for the provision of emergency disaster debris removal and disposal services.


