WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to install lighting in the fields at the Miami Gardens Community Center, and

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville has awarded Bid Number SC-0511-06 for sports lighting, to Musco Sports Lighting, LLC, and

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Gardens would like to rely upon that certain City of Jacksonville Bid Number SC-0511-06,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.



A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER TO MUSCO SPORTS LIGHTING, LLC, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$222,335.00 BY RELYING UPON THAT CERTAIN CITY OF JACKSONVILLE BID SC-0511-06; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Staff Summary

The attached resolution is requesting the authorization by City Council to issue a purchase order to Musco Sports Lighting, LLC in the amount of \$222,335 for athletic sports lighting along the track and football field at the Miami Gardens Community Center. Originally designated for Phase II, sports lighting for the track and football field was not incorporated into the original design. As the facility, upon certificate of use, will be utilized for day and night time games, proper illumination of the facility is warranted.

Staff identified a qualified municipal contract that can be utilized for these services; the attached quote reflect the pricing utilizing the City of Jacksonville bid SC-0511-06. The City of Jacksonville competitively bid for park and playground equipment, Musco Sports Lighting, LLC was awarded sports lighting.

The new field lighting is reflective of the standardized design for all future park designs, exhibiting L.E.E.D. (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) elements, green

principles and focused projection allowing minimal reflection into neighboring residences.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that City Council approve the attached resolution authorizing the issuance of a purchase order for the purchase of athletic sports lighting for Miami Gardens Community Center, in accordance with the City of Jacksonville bid in the amount of \$222,335.00 to Musco Sports Lighting, LLC.

Payment Terms

Payment of 25% of the contract price is required with order. The contract balance is due net 30 days.

Late payment will be subject to service charges of 1 ½% per month (18% APR).

Musco will attempt to coordinate shipment so that delivery corresponds with the customer's payment schedule. It will be the responsibility of the wholesaler to ensure that Musco is aware of this delivery timeframe. We will expect payment within the terms described above unless there is a written statement from Musco's corporate headquarters stating the acceptance of different terms.

Delivery to the job site from the time of order, submittal approval, and confirmation of order details including voltage and phase, pole locations is approximately 30-45 days. Due to the built-in custom light control per luminaire, pole locations need to be confirmed prior to production. Changes to pole locations after the product is sent to production could result in additional charges.

- Field size per the provided site plan
- 480 Volt, 3 Phase electrical system requirement
- Structural code and wind speed = 2004 w/2006 HVHZ supplement, FBC, 146 MPH.
