

RESOLUTION NO. 2008 -155-842

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE AT A PUBLIC HEARING, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2008, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2009; ESTABLISHING THE ROLLBACK RATE; SETTING A DATE AND TIME FOR A FINAL PUBLIC HEARING TO ADOPT THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE; PROVIDING FOR DIRECTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 24, 2008, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2008-153-839 determining a proposed Millage Rate for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2008 ("Fiscal Year 2008/2009"), and scheduling the public hearings required by Section 200.065 of the Florida Statutes to be held on September 9, 2008 and September 24, 2008, at 6:00 p.m. and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended an annual budget for fiscal year 2008-2009 commencing October 1, 2008, and

WHEREAS, the public and all interested parties will have the opportunity to address their comments to the City Council and the City Council will consider the comments of the public regarding the proposed millage rate,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. COMPUTATION OF THE ROLLBACK RATE: The roll-back rate for FY 2008/2009 is \$5.1402.

Section 3. ADOPTION OF PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE: The City Council hereby adopts and establishes the proposed millage rate for the City of Miami Gardens for FY 2008/2009 at 5.1402, which is which is \$5.1402 per \$1,000.00 of assessed property within the City of Miami Gardens, Florida.

Section 4: ESTABLISHMENT OF DATE, TIME AND PLACE OF PUBLIC HEARING: The date, time and place of the public hearing to adopt a final millage rate and budget for Fiscal Year 2008/2009 is hereby set for Wednesday September 24, 2008 at 6:00 p.m. at the City of Miami Gardens City Council Chambers, 1515 N.W. 167th Street, Miami Gardens, Florida 33169.

Section 4. DIRECTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK: The City Clerk is directed to advertise said public hearing as required by law and to send certified copies of this resolution to the Property Appraiser, Tax Collector, and the Miami-Dade County Board of County Commissioners.

Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE: This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.

Staff Summary
