

## Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-housing Program (HPRP)

Beginning October 1, 2009, the City of Miami Gardens is partnering with Citrus Health Network, Inc. to provide homeless prevention assistance to residents of Miami Gardens who are at or below 50% of the area median income. Assistance and services are available to individuals and families who are at risk of becoming homeless or to help those who are currently experiencing homelessness. These funds will provide for a variety of assistance, including: short- and medium-term rental assistance and housing relocation and stabilization services, including such activities as mediation, credit counseling, security or utility deposits, utility payments, moving cost assistance, and case management. These eligible activities are intentionally focused on housing - either financial assistance to help pay for housing, or services designed to keep people in housing or to find housing.

Minimum eligibility requires you to live in the City of Miami Gardens and be at or below the income limits listed below for your family size.
