Nature of Work:

Performs professional, administrative and supervisory tasks directing the operations and activities of the City of Miami Gardens Police Department. This work includes planning, organizing and administering all Police Department programs, assignment of specific tasks to subordinates and evaluation of work to ensure achievement of Police Department goals. Assignments are varied and require independence, judgment and analytical thinking and are carried out in accordance with established practices, precedents and applicable legal procedures. Duties require shift work; work outside normal hours and exposure to the elements and danger. This position exercises supervision over all Police Department staff directly or through subordinate supervisors. The Chief of Police works under the general guidance of the City Manager.

Minimum Requirements:

Bachelors degree from an accredited college or university with major coursework in Public Administration or a related field, Master degree preferred; and fifteen (15) years of previous experience providing law enforcement services in a local government environment including a minimum of five (5) years of leadership experience at the rank of Major or above. FDLE certification required. Must possess and maintain a valid driver license.
