Duties include customer service, telephone answering, typing, word processing, data entry, record keeping, and filing. Performs other related duties as assigned.

Minimum requirements:

High school diploma or equivalent; Associate's degree desirable; Two (2) years of experience in investigation or enforcement of zoning regulations, building and/or environmental nuisance codes, or solid waste disposal codes; or any acceptable related combination of training and experience. **Florida Association of Code Enforcement Certification Level I required**; Level II desirable. Must possess and maintain a valid Florida driver's license throughout employment. Applicants must be able to work some holidays, weekends and evening hours.
