Nature of Work:

Under regular supervision, performs technically skilled public works maintenance and construction activities. Employees in this class typically operate a variety of tools, vehicles and equipment to accomplish duties. Work usually requires maintaining close engineering tolerances. Reports to Stormwater Supervisor or designee.

Minimum Requirements:

High school diploma or GED. At least (2) two years of experience performing public works or large scale commercial construction/maintenance tasks, or an equivalent combination of training and experience that provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities. A valid State of Florida Class "B" CDL with an N Endorsement and a Stormwater Class "C" or a Stormwater Operator - Level 1 Certification is required. An OSHA approved trench safety certificate and a Right of Way and Aquatic Pest Control Pesticide certification must be obtained within six (6) months of employment in this position. **The probationary period may be extended for up to an additional six (6) months (for a total of twelve months) in order to allow for the trench safety certification requirement to be met.**
