### **METHOD OF AWARD:**

Award of this contract will be made to all responsive, responsible bidders, who meet the minimum qualifications set forth in this solicitation.

- Bidders must provide proof they have been engaged in the asphalt business for a minimum of 1 year, within the last 3 years.
- Bidders must have a dedicated phone and fax line, as well as on-line capabilities to receive request for quotations.
- Bidder's office must be staffed with a qualified person to answer questions and inquiries.
- Bidder's office and plant should be located in the South Florida area in Miami-Dade or Broward Counties.

These bidders shall be pre-qualified to participate in subsequent spot market purchases as required by the City. When such spot market purchases are initiated, the pre-qualified bidders shall be invited to offer a fixed price for a ninety (90) calendar day purchasing period. Purchasing periods may be extended for as long as the awarded bidder(s) can hold a fixed price, if in the best interests of the City and the Co-op. The bidder offering the lowest fixed price shall be awarded



the specific purchasing period.

It shall be the sole prerogative of the City as to the number of bidders who will be initially included under this contract. During the term of the contract, the City reserves the right to add or delete bidders as it deems in its best interests. If the City elects to add bidders, they must meet the same minimum qualifications established for the original competition.

**PAYMENT:**

Payment will be made upon receipt and acceptance of each order but not more than every thirty days. No down or partial down payments will be made. All proposed prices must be F.O.B., manufacturer plant.

Bidder shall submit a lump sum price inclusive of all labor, parts/supplies needed to supply and load the asphalt material described herein.

**PRICES SHALL BE FIXED AND FIRM:**

The prices proposed on the Proposal Form shall remain fixed and firm during the specified spot market purchasing period

**MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS:**

**SCOPE OF WORK:**

Furnish and load City trucks with Asphalt Concrete Surfacing Material for pick up by City Staff, on an as-needed, when-needed basis.

**ASPHALT TYPE S-III:**

Asphalt shall be hot plant mix material meeting the requirements of Section 320 Hot Bituminous Mixtures-Plant Methods and Equipment of the Florida Department of Transportation "Standard Specification for Road and Bridge Construction," Version 2010 revision.

Proposed design mix shall be approved by the City's representative and as provided by job mix formula for bituminous concrete.

Mix not meeting the above specifications will not be accepted and dumped at vendor's facility at vendor's expense. Vendor shall reload City truck with acceptable mix.

**PICKUP/ FEES:**

Prices bid per ton are to include all charges, including cost of product and any loading fees.
